Anti-doping Control

Oceania Track Championships 20-23 Nov 2017

1. Doping control officers appointed by Cycling Anti-Doping Foundation are Rob Ingall and Seungwoo (Francis) Paik. The CADF is an independent body mandated by UCI to carry out the anti-doping program in cycling.

2. A certain amount of controls will be conducted under the 2017 Anti-Doping rules of the UCI and CADF procedures and instructions.

3. Doping control will be conducted in Doping Control Room in level 1 in Avantidrome

4. A list of riders who will be subject to doping control will be posted at the doping control station and near the finish line.

5. The rider who has abandoned the race shall proceed immediately to the doping control station. The absence of notification by a chaperone shall not excuse the rider for not reporting in time to the doping control station.

6. The riders who are selected for doping control must report for testing as soon as possible and must come to the doping control station within 30 minutes after finishing the race. If a rider takes part in an official ceremony or attends a press conference, the deadline shall be 30 minutes of the end

of official ceremony or of the moment that his presence is no longer required at the press conference. When riders come to the doping control station, they must bring the appropriate licenses with photo and come along with their team managers.

7. The riders who have not checked the posted information of the selected riders for the doping control and have not provided the sample have the possibility of being considered as having constituted an anti-doping rule violation.

8. For riders that are minors, it is recommended that riders representatives be present with the rider from notification until completion of testing

I request the cooperation of all riders and managers participating in this event.
